Although our board meetings have moved to zoom we've still managed to meet face-to-face in smaller numbers, we've kept busy, safe, and excited about our continued efforts to support young people during these unprecedented times.

What we've been up to...

Thanks to your kind and generous support, we have now approved funding for 8 absolutely amazing young people helping them to get on with a whole variety of activities that will help their futures. We have also provided mentoring support for 4 other applicants to help guide them and provide networking opportunities. We are continuing to meet every month via Zoom to run the charity, speak about fundraising and of course, share a few pints together (virtually) after all of our hard work.

Here's what else has been happening:

- Members of our board and close friends of the charity rode their own 55km bike ride, after the cancellation of the annual London to Brighton cycle, and raised an incredible £5,086!
- We have partnered with two schools in Wanaka, New Zealand to help provide access to a range of snow activities.
- We have continued our relationship with Afterjam, where Yolanda was a brand ambassador, to support five aspiring athletes.

- So far we have shared 20% of our fundraised pot with applicants, we have now raised a total of nearly £50,000.
- The number of applicants that have applied this year has risen by 87% (so far!).


Yousra is a passionate mathematician and tutor who we're proud to have supported. She wrote back to us to tell us the following:





2. WE GRANT FUNDING BASED ON THE NEEDS IDENTIFIED THROUGH MENTORING

After a mentoring session we revisit the individuals application and decide whether funding is still required. If it is a necessary next step we decide as a board how much to allocate based on what we have learnt about the applicant during mentoring sessions. This funding can be to help towards travel costs so they can attend work experience or it can be the cost of a short course that they need to take the next step.
